## Our School

Our summer school is located 15 minutes from Bournemouth Pear and City Centre close to Lansdowne area of Bournemouth. It is an open city campus with easy access to the beach & city centre. We have great facilities for indoor activities.



## School Facilities

- Spacious classrooms in our IP school with interactive whiteboards
- Spacious classrooms in the college only 7 minutes away

## Airports and Airport Transfers

- **Bournemouth Airport:** 6 miles, ca. 20 minutes, airport transfer with private coach or taxi at any time as requested
- **Southampton Airport:** 35 miles, ca. 1 hour; airport transfer with private coach or taxi at any time as requested
- **Bristol Airport:** 76 miles, ca. 3 hours; airport transfer with private coach or taxi at any time as requested
- **London Gatwick** 115 miles, ca. 2,5 hours; airport transfer with private coach or taxi at any time as requested
- **London Luton** 122 miles, ca. 2,75 hours; airport transfer with private coach or taxi at any time as requested
- **London Stansted** 152 miles, ca. 3 hours; airport transfer with private coach or taxi at any time as requested
- **London Heathrow** 93 miles, ca. 2 hours; airport transfer with private coach or taxi at any time as requested OR **Low Cost Transfer from Heathrow** for students coming into Heathrow on a Saturday or Sunday before 17:00. Terminal 5 / Meeting Point for 17:00. An IP staff member will be at the airport to welcome each student between the hours of 10:00 and 17:00. The coach to the centre will depart at 18:00. For departure: 08:00 from Bournemouth to arrive at London Heathrow around 11:00. Bear in mind, check in time is 2 hours before take-off. This requires a flight departure from Heathrow after 14:00.

On the day of departure, we will drop each student off at the airport. If they would like to be taken directly to the check-in desk, please inquire about our **Unaccompanied Minor Service**. Please keep in mind that a return UM-Service must be booked if your student uses the UM-service on arrival.

## Accommodation and Catering

### Residence Purbeck House:

- 10 floors with 2 or 3 flats (~5 rooms per flat)
- All rooms are lockable with en-suite facilities (toilets and showers in each room)
- Beds, desks, and wardrobes with one shelf and one hanging rail (no hangers)
- Toilets and showers in each room
- Floor: carpet
- Distance to school: 0,2 miles
- Address: Purbeck House, 5-7 Oxford Road, Bournemouth, Dorset, BH8 8ES

### Hotel Accomodation:

- Students live in single or triple rooms
- All rooms are lockable with en-suite facilities (toilets and showers in each room)
- Floor: carpet
- Beds and wardrobes with one shelf and one hanging rail
- Free wifi-access
- Breakfast will be provided in the Hotels, lunch and dinner in the IP Language School refectory
- Please bring towels, also for the beach
- Bedding is provided and changed weekly
- Rooms and washrooms are cleaned daily
- No safe available, but all rooms are lockable

### Carrington House Hotel

- Indoor swimming pool (dates will be provided in the centre)
- Big function rooms where afternoon and evening activities will take place
- Distance to:
  - School approx. 10 minute walk
  - City Centre approx. 10-15 minute walk
  - Beach approx. 5-10 minute walk

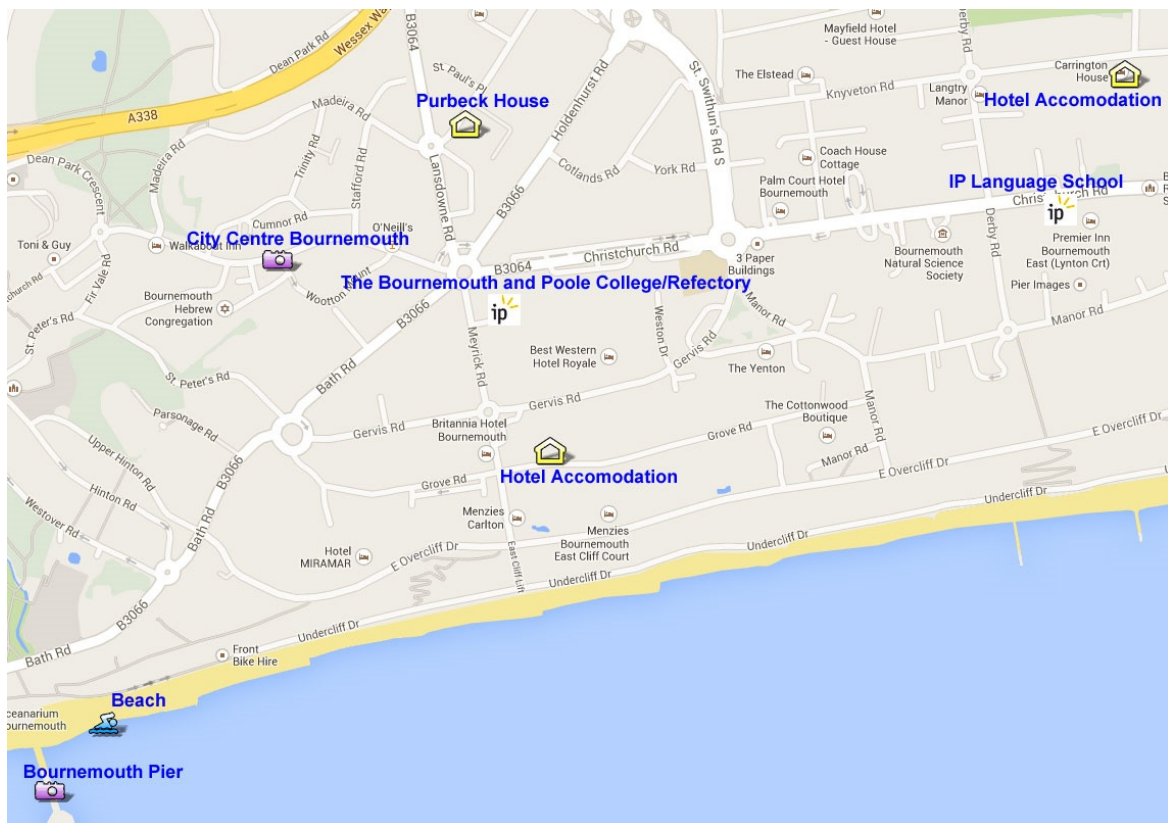
### Heathlands Hotel

### Home Stay Accommodation:

- Students will share a room with peers of the same sex in **twin** rooms, however **single** or **triple** accommodation is a possibility. Different nationalities per room or host possible.
- Students receive breakfast, a packed-lunch, and dinner
- Bedding: Provided and changed weekly
- Towels: Not provided
- A reasonable amount of laundry is included in the household wash
- During peak season it is possible that a maximum of four students from two different nationalities are placed in one home
- Access to the household in the afternoon and evenings
- Hosts assist students with travel between home and IP centre on the first day of school
- In Bournemouth normally 30, but max. 60 minutes by bus from school (costs for public transportation not included)
- Students aged 12 and below will receive a transfer from their home stay provider to the centre and back if the family lives farther away than half a mile walking distance (pick up in the morning / drop off in time for dinner). If a transfer needs to be arranged, students are not able to participate in the evening programme. **If you would like to avoid missing the evening programme, we strongly advise you to stay in the residence.**

## Lessons

- Our summer school is accredited by the British Council and ISI
- Take place at the Europa School of English (Christchurch Road, Bournemouth) or at the Hotel
- Modern equipped classrooms at the IP School

### Courses available:

- **General English Course** (15 x 45 minutes per week), (A1-C1), 9:00-11:45 including breaks
- **Intensive English Course** (20 x 45 minutes per week), (A1-C1), 9:00-13:30 including breaks
- **Super-Intensive Course** (25 x 45 minutes per week), (A2-C1), 9:00-13:30 including breaks and on Monday and Wednesday from 14:00-16:00 including break
- All our courses follow the European Framework of Reference Levels
- **Levels:** Beginners (A0), Advanced beginners (A1), Lower Intermediate (A2), Intermediate (B1), Upper Intermediate (B2), and Advanced (C1)
- **Placement Test:** on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of class at 9:00, class allocation on Tuesday (Monday for Super-Intensive Course)
- Teaching material provided
- **IP Certificate** at the end of the course
- No more than **15 students (Club 4: 4)** are assigned per group. Generally students' native languages vary, but they are of similar age.
- **90 % of our teachers are native speakers** and a maximum of 10 % are native level speakers. All of our teachers are qualified to teach English as a Foreign Language, which means they have either a TEFL qualification or a teaching qualification (PGCE Primary / PGCE Secondary for Modern Languages).
- **Bank holidays:** 18<sup>th</sup> of April, 21<sup>st</sup> of April, 5<sup>th</sup> of May and 26<sup>th</sup> of May – lessons will not be replaced

## Special Programme

### Surf course

Bournemouth is ideal for surfing (wave riding). If you want to get a feel for riding the waves, then be sure to join the surfing course at our partner school. The surfing course consists of five afternoons with two hour lessons each. Equipment will be provided. The times for surfing lessons can vary depending on the weather, tide, and the size of the waves. Please be aware that it might not be possible to join the activity programme or scheduled excursions. This special is not included in the programme but can be chosen at the time of booking as an upgrade.

### London Overnight Trip (minimum age: 13 years)

During our guided tour we will pass Trafalgar Square, The Mall, Buckingham Palace, Birdcage Walk, the Houses of Parliament, Big Ben, Westminster Abbey, London Eye, and Piccadilly Circus (entrance fees are not included). After our tour it's shopping time (Oxford-, Regent and Carnaby Street). You will spend the night in a hostel and have some more time for shopping and sightseeing the next day.

### Excursions

#### Full-day trip London 08:00-22:00

During our guided tour we will pass Trafalgar Square, The Mall, Buckingham Palace, Birdcage Walk, the Houses of Parliament, Big Ben, Westminster Abbey, London Eye, and Piccadilly Circus (entrance fees are not included). After our tour it's shopping time (Oxford &, Regent and Carnaby Street).

#### Full-day trip Bath 08:30 – 18:00

After a guided tour around the city your free time may be spent for shopping or visiting place of interest like Roman Bath & Pump Room, Pulteney Bridge, Bath Abbey, or the Royal Crescent (entrance fees not included).

#### Half-day trip to Poole ca.14:00-18:00

Visit of South Sea Castle followed by shopping at Gunwharf Quays.

#### Half-day trip to Old Harry Rocks ca.14:00-17:00

After our arrival we will take a sightseeing walk, viewing the cathedral and castle – home to King Arthur's Round Table (entrance fees not included). After our walk, you will have time to spend shopping or visiting the rest of town.

#### Half-day trip to Christchurch ca.14:00-18:00

During this half-day excursion we will take a walk through town, passing the cathedral (entrance not included) while we gaze at the ancient buildings all around us. After our walk you are free to spend time shopping or exploring Salisbury's history.

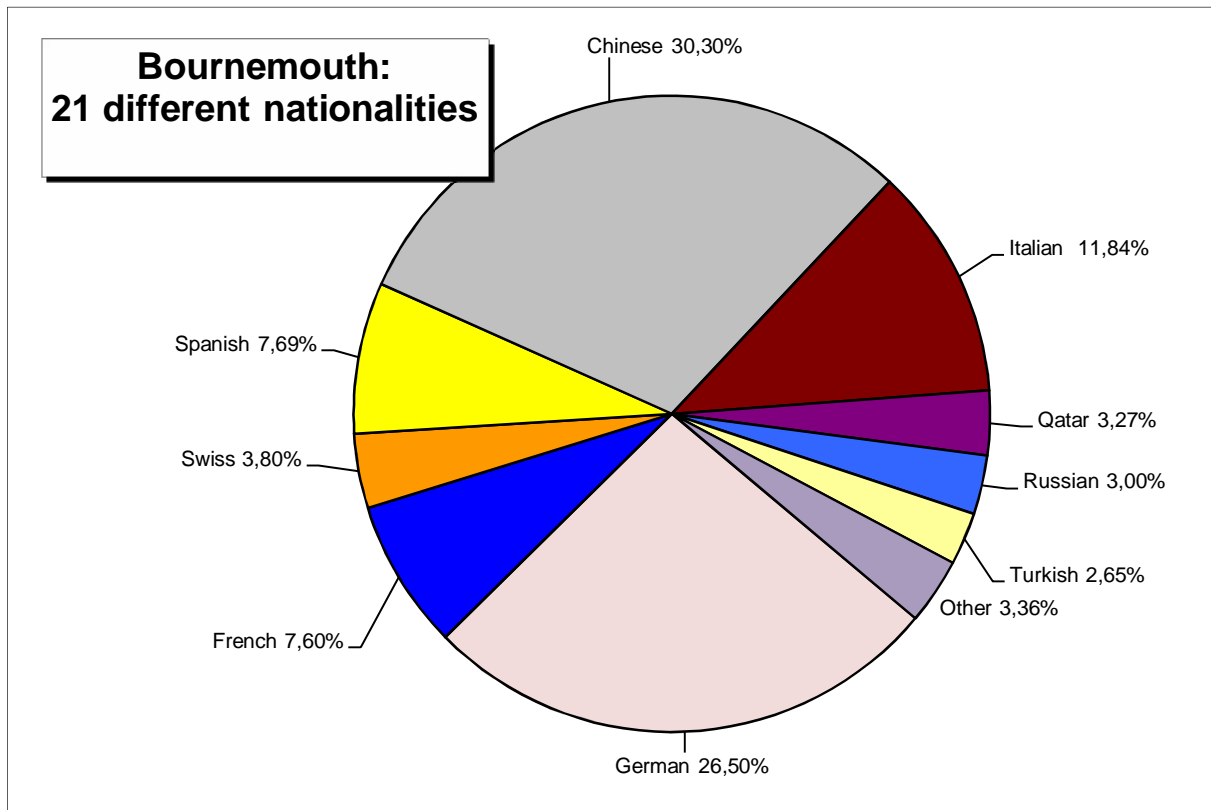


### Supervision

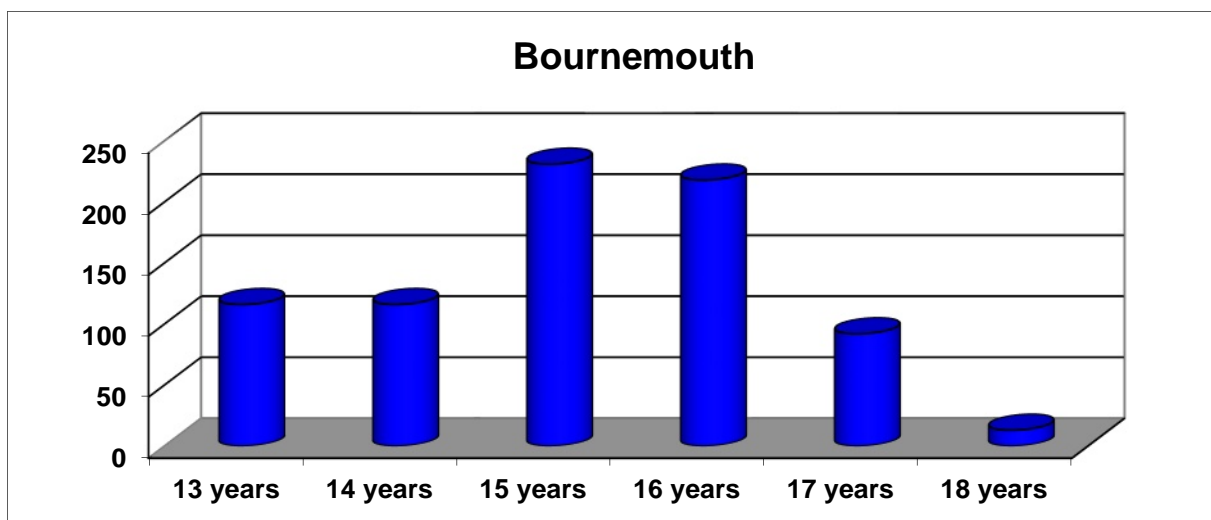
Our friendly and helpful **International Team** will run a supervised activity programme and guarantee supervision. They have been trained in three different sessions totaling ten days of intense preparation for their summer job. Our supervision ratio is based on age groups, for the age group 13 and older we follow a ratio of 1:15, for students 12 and younger 1:10.
